What will the design promote?

Built around the theme — A New Season of Wellbeing in Libraries — it should showcase what libraries in 2022 offer children and young people (like you!). Think about how they connect with their community (groups and activities) and offer support and promote wellbeing.



Your artwork can be hand drawn, painted or produced digitally. It can use drawings or photographs, pictures, words or both. The choice is yours.

When do entries have to be in?

Terms and conditions: This competition is open to 11-to-18-year-olds, based in the UK. If you are under 16 you must have your parent or guardian's permission before entering. The winners will be selected by our judging panel and notified via email. The judges' decision is final.

Did You Know?



Your library ticket is a gateway to any place and any time. You can find out about any country or culture and any point in history, past, present or future!

There are hundreds of public libraries across Wales, all a safe, friendly, welcoming place (often with a nice café inside so you can grab a coffee).

Libraries have a whole range of clubs and activities you can take part in - from reading groups to creative writing workshops, Coding or craft clubs to fitness sessions. And if they don't run what you're after, they'll be able to signpost a local organisation that does!

There are audio books as well as printed versions of great reads, or try some of the comics, magazines and graphic novels that are on offer.

If you have a special interest (music, drama, science, sport, nature, animals, legends, movies, fashion...) the librarian will point you to some great reads to match.





You no longer even have to visit the library to take advantage of what's on offer. If you have a smart device you can borrow eBooks and audiobooks remotely using BorrowBox.

You can use computers free of charge and get online. Libraries are a brilliant place to do your homework or studying, providing free online access to a range of digital reference resources.
