## What will be needed?

Don't worry! No need for beakers and test tubes! We will use every day, inexpensive items that are easy to source. Ensuring the availability of some smart devices will be useful, as additional digital challenges will be designed for learners who complete tasks ahead of time.

## How will the sessions be held?

The sessions are held via MS Teams. We strongly suggest that any teacher who registers makes every effort to attend each session live to get the full benefit from the sessions. However, all sessions are recorded and added to our YouTube channel in case a class is unable to attend a session in real-time.

- Sessions will last approximately one hour.
- We will make use of the 'Chat' within MS Teams in case questions arise.
- The classroom microphones and cameras will not be on.
- We may end sessions with a Kahoot quiz. Learners will not need a tablet either. We suggest that you play as a class, with the teacher in charge of the answers.
